Early Drop-Off and Aftercare Options for All Children

EARLY DROP-OFF: Any time between 7:30 AM and 8:50 AM:	\$ 8.00 per day
AFTERCARE PICK-UP: Any time between 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM (5:30 PM on Fridays)	\$ 18.00 per day
SPECIAL AFTERCARE PICKUP OPTION - 3:30 PM	\$ 8.00 per day
FULL-TIME (5 days per week) AFTERCARE paid in advance:	\$270.00 per month

* Reminder: No make-up days, exchanging of days, or money refunded for school closings due to holidays, snow days or unforeseen building emergencies

A \$200.00 non-refundable deposit registers your child for our 2012-2013 school year.

Tuition Payments: 25% (1/4) of your child's total tuition must be paid by July 23, 2012 to hold your registration class spot. The next 25% (half of your child's total tuition) is due by September 21, 2012. The third payment of 25% is due by December 10, 2012; the final balance is due by February 15, 2013. In order for your child to return to school for the second semester (beginning January 7, 2013) or to register for Summer Camp 2013 and the 2013-2014 School Year, 75% (3/4) of your child's total tuition must be paid in full. Please note: if the final tuition balance is not paid in full by February 15, 2013, your child cannot return to school after Spring Break and your child's name will be removed from our summer and fall registration rosters. All early drop-off and after school bills must be paid monthly upon receipt of the bill in order for your child to continue using our extended day program. A discount will be provided for the 2nd child of the same family. Total tuition for the less expensive child will be reduced by 10%.

Schedule Changes (which also includes dismissal time changes): If you make schedule changes for the school year after July 23, 2012, you will be charged a \$50.00 change fee per child per change. PLEASE NOTE: No change fee charged when "adding" a day to your child's schedule.

A parent only orientation meeting will be held on Monday, August 13, 2012 at 7:00 PM at Beth-El Zedeck.
Open house visit for parent and child on Tuesday, August 14, 2012, anytime from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM.
