Early Drop-Off and Aftercare Options for All Children

EARLY DROP-OFF: Any time between 7:30 AM and 8:50 AM: \$ 8.00 per day

AFTERCARE PICK-UP: Any time between 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM (5:30 PM on Fridays) \$ 18.00 per day

NEW: Special Aftercare pickup option – 3:30 PM Flat fee per semester

FULL-TIME (5 days per week) **AFTERCARE** paid in advance: \$260.00 per month

* Reminder: No make-up days, exchanging of days, or money refunded for school closings due to holidays, snow days or unforeseen building emergencies

A \$200.00 non-refundable deposit registers your child for our 2010-2011 school year.

Tuition Payments: 25% (1/4) of your child's total tuition **must be paid by July 23, 2010 to hold your registration class spot.** The next 25% (half of your child's total tuition) **is due by September 20, 2010.** The third payment of 25% **is due by December 17, 2010;** the **final balance is due by February 18, 2011.** In order for your child to return to school for the second semester (beginning January 3, 2011) or to register for Summer Camp 2011 and the 2011-2012 School Year, 75% (3/4) of your child's total tuition must be paid in full. Please note: if the final tuition balance is not paid in full by February 18, 2011, your child cannot return to school after Spring Break and your child's name will be removed from our summer and fall registration rosters. All early drop-off and after school bills must be paid monthly upon receipt of the bill in order for your child to continue using our extended day program. A discount will be provided for the 2nd child of the same family. Total tuition for the less expensive child will be reduced by 10%.

Schedule Changes: If you make schedule changes for the school year after July 23, 2010, you will be charged a \$50.00 **change fee per child per change.** PLEASE NOTE: No change fee charged when "adding" a day to your child's schedule.

A parent orientation meeting will be held on Monday, August 16, 2010 at 7:00 PM at Beth-El Zedeck.

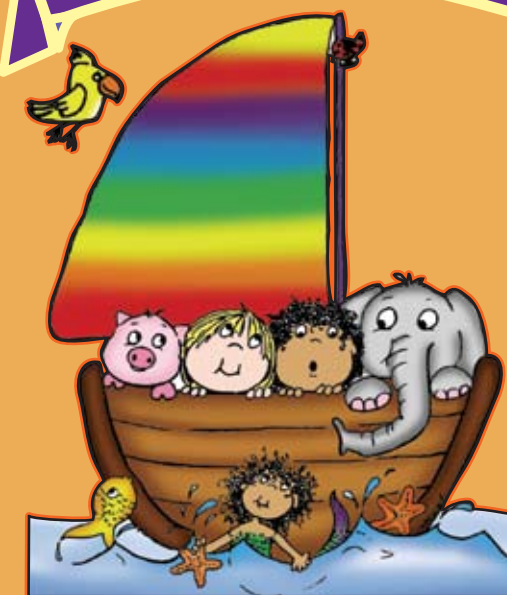
